



'A Christmas Story' Bible Study

Director Bob Clark's charming, touching, and very funny adaptation of humorist Jean Shepherd's nostalgic, autobiographical Yuletide novel, *In God We Trust, All Others Pay Cash*, is considered by many to be essential holiday family viewing. Narrated by a man (Shepherd) recalling his childhood, the film *A Christmas Story* looks back at the compulsive efforts of 7-year-old Ralphie (Peter Billingsley) as he tries every means possible to acquire his dream Christmas gift—a Daisy-brand Red Ryder repeating BB carbine with a compass mounted in the stock. Problem is, he lives in a Norman Rockwell-esque Midwestern town in the 1940s, where his parents, teachers, and even Santa Claus all warn Ralphie that "he'll shoot his eye out." Episodic in nature and seen entirely through the eyes of a child, the film offers a wonderful look at the day-to-day eccentricities that grew out of this conservative period. More interestingly, it cleverly captures childhood urgency, where even the most trivial fantasies or objects become immediate life-or-death necessities.



Blood Donor Sunday


Our next Blood Donor Sunday will be held January 8, 8 a.m. to 12:30 p.m. in the gym. If you would prefer a special time, please sign up online at https://www.commitforlife.org/donor/schedules/drive_schedule/338574. While scheduling an appointment ahead of time gives us an estimate of how many donors to expect and the Blood Center sends out the appropriate number of workers; an added bonus is we take scheduled appointments prior to walk-ups. All successful donors will receive a free hoodie.

We look forward to a very successful drive. Double red cell and combination whole blood and plasma machines will be available for those wishing to donate that way. Both count for two donations.

Save time with the DIGITAL DONOR APP. The App makes it easy to find a blood drive, schedule your donation and answer the CFL Express Pass health history interview before you arrive.

REMINDER!! The minimum donor age requirement to give blood is 16 years old with a parent's permission. Weight must be 122 lbs. (still 110 lbs. for 17 and older) and in general good health.

REMEMBER: one unit of blood can save as many as three lives as it is broken down into three components – red blood cells, platelets and plasma.

Finance Corner - December 2022

Our Magnify Capital Campaign is off to a great start with “First Fruits” gifts through mid-November totaling over \$190,000 (or 25%) of our \$750,000 total. Thank you so much for your generosity!

Tithes and offerings for the month of October were 4% higher than our monthly budget, **but we still lag our YTD budget by about \$118,000, or 8%. Our current projections indicate that we may wind up at the end of 2022 with a \$20,000-\$40,000 deficit.** Your gifts of time, treasure and prayer are an important way you can participate in sharing the love of Christ to our city, so **please prayerfully consider making a special gift to help us catch up.** You can make a real difference in Trinity's ability to impact and reach out to our community, as God works His work among us.

Feeling Stressed This Holiday Season?

The “holiday season” can be a time of great joy as we see friends and family members, collectively say “thank you” for our blessings and celebrate Jesus’ birth. Holidays can also be one of the most stressful times of the year, especially if you are grieving the loss of a loved one.

Here are some steps that might help you take control of stress:

- Recognize that you may be emotional or feel sad, and that’s perfectly okay.
- Temper your expectations—it may APPEAR that your friends and family members “have it all together”. They don’t, so don’t put added pressure on yourself by trying to hide your emotions.
- Don’t be afraid to make changes to your family’s holiday traditions if they are causing you undue stress. Do what you can do and don’t chastise yourself for what you cannot do.



Are you feeling sad or anxious during this season? Are you grieving the loss of a loved one during this holiday season? Do you need to bring your feelings to the feet of our Lord? God never intended for us to go through these challenges alone. Reach out to Trinity’s Stephen Ministry for assistance. Stephen Ministers are laypeople in our congregation trained to provide one-to-one, Christ-centered care to individuals facing difficult times in life—grief, cancer, divorce, financial difficulties, hospitalization, chronic illness, job loss, disability, loneliness, a spiritual crisis, or other life struggles. They have a compassionate heart for those who are hurting, and they have been equipped with caring ministry skills by their congregation’s Stephen Leaders. A Stephen Minister typically has one care receiver at a time and meets with that person once a week to listen, care, pray, encourage, and offer emotional and spiritual support.





Led by Pastor Jose Flores of Casa 'de Oracion - 10:15-11:15 AM - Room 211 - In Person




